** The Avi Chai Foundation reports that more than 80% of the past 10 years of mechina graduates volunteer in their communities after finishing their army service.

*** Two Mechina graduates were hired to conduct a survey of every Mechinat Rabin graduate. The results will provide an important picture and insight into the mid- to long-term impact of the Mechina on the graduates' experience as leaders and activists in Israeli society.
