| 1.                 | Sick, single mother + 3 children   | Largest project ever undertaken by the organization – complete makeover of home of soldier – covered by Channel 2 News. Drained accumulated sewage under the home and replaced plumbing system, totally replaced kitchen and bathroom, replaced flooring, painted walls throughout the home, sourced contributions of doors, furniture, appliances, beds and more. |
| 2.                 | Couple + 7 children, immigrants from Ethiopia  | Half of the home had no electricity. Fixed the electricity, repaired and painted walls throughout the home.  |
| 3.                 | Single mother with cancer + 3 children, one with Down Syndrome. Immigrants from Ethiopia | Repaired and painted walls throughout the home, fixed the air conditioner, replaced electrical sockets and switches.   |
| 4.                 | Elderly man, hoarder   | Cleared hoarded items, disinfected and painted home. Our work enabled the man to begin receiving aid from Social Services.   |
| 5.                 | Couple + 6 children  | Repaired damage that cockroaches had caused in the ceiling, repaired and painted walls, built a room for a grown son including electricity and installing a door   |
| 6.                 | Single mother + 2 children, father in jail   | Affixed tiles that had come up in the shower, repaired broken shutters, repaired exposed electrical connections, fixed leaks in the kitchen sink, fixed the faucet in the bathroom, installed light fixtures, repaired and painted walls   |
| 7.                 | Single mother + 3 grown children   | Cleared a rotted kitchen cabinet, replaced tiling, moved fridge and washing machine, repaired electricity and added new electrical sockets, repaired and painted walls throughout the home   |
| 8.                 | Single father, widower, + 6 children – 3 minors in special education, hoarder            | Cleared entire home, replaced 7 lighting fixtures  |
| 9.                 | Elderly woman  | Cleared old kitchen, replaced with new including cabinets, countertop, sink and faucets. Repaired broken window, repaired and painted walls throughout the home.   |
| 10.                | Couple + 2 grown developmentally challenged daughters                                    | Repaired and painted walls throughout the home   |
| 11.                | Single mother + 3 children   | Repaired and painted walls throughout the home, replaced electrical sockets and switches including the switch for the hot water heater   |
| 12.                | Poverty stricken young couple+5  | Repaired and painted the walls, fixed two doors and replaced electric  |

| 13. | Single mother + 6 children, father in jail, Arab family   | House had no bath or bathroom, painted children's room, electrical sockets and switches and installed 6 lighting fixtures  |
| 14. | Elderly couple, Arab family   | Repaired and painted walls throughout the home.  |
| 15. | Elderly couple + 3 children, Arab family  | Repaired and painted walls throughout the home.  |
| 16. | Couple + 8 children, one child developmentally challenged, Arab family. Father has cancer and diabetes and is on dialysis | House has no lighting. Painted entire home. Replaced 8 lighting fixtures.  |
| 17. | Single mother+4. The house is in desperate condition.   | Changed dangerous electrical sockets, plastered and painted walls, changed the toilet seat, and fixed broken shower equipment  |
| 18. | Elderly couple, sickly, extremely destitute. Divorced daughter living with them   | Hard plaster' work, painted the entire home, changed all the dangerous electrical sockets and light switches. Fixed the entire plumbing system, and water system.  |
| 19. | Single mother+8, aged 2.5-16. After being in a battered women shelter for 2 years.  | The dysfunctional bathroom fixed, and the entire home was painted. We mounted new light fixtures.  |
| 20. | Aged sickly couple  | Treated mold and broken plaster in the bathroom and fixed the falling plaster in the bedroom. Painted and repaired walls in the living room, and replaced dangerous electrical sockets. Repaired the broken hot-water system |
| 21. | Elderly single mother, with older children living with her.   | Fixed the entire plaster that was falling apart. Changed the plumbing system in the toilet room, and installed a grab rail.  |
| 22. | Arab Family. Elderly widow  | Very old and crumbling home. Fixed the walls, and electrical system in the kitchen. Fixed the dangerous stem in the home entry   |
