The program is on-going and is in its fourth year. Professor Idel continues in his role as leading senior lecturer in the Mysticism and Spiritualties department. He continues to teach academic courses, give lectures abroad and in Israel, attend conferences and publish books and articles.

The main achievements during the last year of activity (main achievements, number of events, number of participants, etc.):

Professor Idel's activities supported by The Matanel Foundation in 2018/2019 included:

 A senior teaching position. Professor Idel is the leading senior lecturer in the Mysticism and Spiritualties department that was established and is operating with his assistance.



Professor Idel's Website is under construction, and the following steps have been taken:

- At a meeting at Zefat Academic College, the first steps of the work on the
 website were discussed. It was decided to establish a full archive of Prof. Idel's
 research projects, according to years of activity (picture of the initial format of
 the Virtual Archive attached below).
- The homepage of the site was submitted to Prof. Idel for approval.
- Links were made to videotaped lectures.
- Prof. Idel decided on the format of the sources and files that will appear on the site. The list was developed in a demo version of the site.
- Prof. Idel's assistant started collecting materials and formulating a work method.
- First articles were added to the database. In the meantime, at the initial stage we are working on the articles in English, the bilingual version of the site there will be access to articles in English and Hebrew.
- The first 60 articles, most of them in English and some in Hebrew, are currently being uploaded to the website.
- Dozens of articles are currently in the process of being located, collected and scanned to be uploaded to the website.

- In 2018/19, Professor Idel taught 4 academic courses in Zefat Academic College, with a total of 35 students.
- The number of courses taught by Professor Idel increased.
- The number of lectures abroad increased.
- The number of lectures in Israel increased.

Professor Idel will continue in his role as leading senior lecturer in the Mysticism and Spiritualties department. He will teach academic courses, give lectures abroad and in Israel, attend conferences and publish books and articles. In addition, his website will be launched.

Zefat Academic College plans to establish a new online course on the subject of Zefat's Kabbalah, which will be taught by Professor Idel.
