Ricki, mother of Aviv, who worked at the Delta retail chain: The preparation and training were no less important than the work itself. My daughter traveled independently to those sessions, an effort which is not taken for granted. She was able to commute to a destination other than school, an important step in building her capacity for independence.

Noa, Shira's supervisor at Superpharm: Shira readily took on the assignments she was given, and was proud to be able to provide customer service. We saw the ways her independence and self-confidence grew on the job.

Sigalit, mother of Yahav, who worked at ToysRUs: We saw how our son's self-confidence grew as he was able to gain proficiency in his work and positive feedback from others. He came up with his own ideas on making improvements on the job, and he felt productive.

Esti, mother of Lihi, who worked at Steimatsky's: Lihi traveled to work by train on her own. This was yet another way that we were exposed to her new capacities for independence. It built her confidence and strengthened us as well.

Bank Discount manager and employer of Yuval: He was an amazing worker who took every task he was given to heart. It was clear how dedicated he was to proving himself.
