Thanks to your support, throughout 2025, 16 girls received individualized care, educational support, and therapy according to her personal rehabilitation plan.

Your support made it possible for us to offer girls not only a safe place to stay, but also deep, supportive emotional care — exactly what they needed most during the most fragile moments of their lives.

These emotional therapy sessions helped the girls regain emotional balance, process past traumas, and gain real tools for the future.

After the therapeutic process, the girls showed significant improvement in emotional stability and self-confidence.

Beit Naomi continues to be a vital lifeline for vulnerable girls, guiding them from crisis to recovery and renewed hope.

Through the program, I learned that when you truly invest in these girls — give them a listening ear, warmth, and the right tools — incredible things can happen. Both the staff and the girls themselves were amazed by the deep transformation that began to unfold: self-confidence grew, trust in the team strengthened, and hearts began to open. During therapy, many girls were finally able to release years of emotional baggage — fears, pain, and feelings they never dared to share before. With a sensitive and professional process, they began to believe once again — in people, and in their own ability to build a better, safer future for themselves.
