PUBLIC READINGS

In the long process of the creation of a play, we organized several free public readings to test “*Vieille Âme*” in front of a real audience (about 300 people) at the **Auderghem Cultural Center** (Brussels) at the beginning of March 2026. We received students from Secondary School (ages between 12 and 18) and people from all ages during the evening reading.

After each reading, we had long Q&A (“bords de scène”) between the audience and actors **Luc Van Grunderbeek** and **Nina Domboy** and Musician **Sarah Chervonaz**. The questions were about the play, the story of Paul Sobol (holocaust survivor), the interview and friendship between Nina and Paul, but the main subject was the Shoah and the transmission of what happened during WWII to young people.

We also made a film recording of one of the event.
